



Dr Molinari is an Associate Research Scientist in the Department of OB/Gyn at Yale University, under the supervision of Dr Pasquale Patrizio. In 2012 she received her PhD from University of Torino, Italy while being trained as a clinical embryologist. Over her graduate career she developed the freezing/thawing protocol that led to the achievement of the first Italian pregnancy after cryopreserved ovarian tissue transplantation. She started her Postdoctoral career at Yale in 2013 and her main research focuses are ovarian aging, identification of sperm competence biomarkers and fertility preservation.
